



NegotiateCOP is an AI-assisted platform that supports negotiators and analysts navigate the vast amount of information in the COP negotiation process.

By processing official UNFCCC submissions from COP29 and COP30, the tool allows users to search, compare, and explore negotiation positions with unprecedented efficiency.

Developed as an open Digital Public Good, NegotiateCOP aims to make negotiation data more transparent and accessible for all — supporting fairer and more informed climate diplomacy.
